



Here is the parental custodial policy of All Saints Catholic Academy as stated on our required Emergency Contact Information Registration Form.

Please attach a certified copy of the court decision bearing the case number and those sections referring to visitation rights and contacts with the school. Also, include the case bearing the judge's signature and court seal. This copy should include any and all modifications made as of date of registration of the child in this school. It is also the responsibility of the parents to inform the Principal of any subsequent modifications during the child's tenure at the school.

Here at All Saints Catholic Academy, we do not mediate custodial matters. In the event that an adult with or without custodial rights attempts to violate the provided written order, law enforcement is called to mediate. The child(ren) involved will remain in the care of school personnel until the matter is resolved by local law enforcement. It is the local policy of All Saints Catholic Academy to not mediate custodial matters, and to keep our students safe in all matters regarding custodial situations. Parents asking to have custodial restrictions enforced at school, are required to have a certified signed and court stamped document with explicit custodial restrictions and allowances that pertain to the academic affairs of education. The school personnel will honor and uphold any and all custodial rights as stated in provided court papers, but will not mediate an infraction.
