Dear Parents and Guardians:

In 1965 the bishops of the Second Vatican Council approved *Gravissimum Educationis* (Declaration on Christian Education). This document calls for Catholics to be formed to live a mature and holy life. To fulfill this document, the Diocese of Albany has adopted RCL Publishing's *Family Life* program. They have chosen resources designed to provide children with wholesome formation in Catholic moral virtues and a positive education in human behavior.

Through this program students will be provided, in an age-appropriate format, knowledge and skills they need to:

- Make good moral decisions.
- Appreciate the wonders and goodness of God's creation.
- Develop a Catholic understanding of human behavior and a reverence for the human body.
- Recognize, respond, and report any inappropriate behavior; thereby promoting student safety.
- Live a healthy, happy and holy family life.

The student and teacher materials in the *Family Life* program have been reviewed by the USCCB and have been found to be in conformity with the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*, and so are deemed to be in accord with Catholic moral principles. The program is organized around five themes in Catholic family living: God's gift of Family, God's gift of Self, God's gift of Life, God's gift of Love and God's gift of Community.
