

Media Science with Mr. Matteo
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Our main objective is to help the students assess, process, and present information in an age-appropriate fashion. We will be learning computer and internet literacy, as well as organizational and functional skills, through the various forms of interactive media, activities, and projects.

Classroom policies are very simple and are designed to curate a professional, yet fun learning environment. Students are expected to enter the room in an orderly manner. They know to quietly take their seat, log into their designated Chromebook, and wait for instruction. Water bottles are permitted in the classroom but must be kept on the floor next to their seat. Food is never permitted in the classroom. Disruptions and rude behavior to any teacher or classmate will not be tolerated as it distracts from the lesson and hinders our educational progress.

Students in K-2 will be slowly introduced to digital literacy through an exploration of various grade appropriate topics. My objective is to make their class period as interactive as possible, with the intention of inspiring imagination and critical thinking.

Students in 3rd-8th are able to access their google accounts from home to work on any documents or projects, as well as notes or links to materials discussed in class. Homework will consist of conducting research related to class projects or discussions, as well as the detailed completion of presentations via different forms of media. (slide shows, documents, voice, video, ect.)

Grading will be based on 50% participation and 50% completion of assignments. Attached are grading rubrics and participation metrics.
