WELCOME TO FIFTH GRADE!

I am thrilled to have your child as my student! This year will be filled with many new and exciting experiences. We will have a **great** time learning and growing together throughout the school year. I'm looking forward to a productive partnership to ensure your student can achieve their highest potential.

GRADING BREAKDOWN

25% - Tests and Projects

A minimum of 1 test or project will be given in each subject area per quarter. Tests will be given at the discretion of the teacher. If a student is absent on the day of a test or the day a project is due, the student will be expected to take the test or hand in the project on the day of their return.

15% - Quizzes

A minimum of 2 quizzes will be given in each subject area per quarter. The lowest quiz grade per quarter will be dropped. If a student is absent on the day of a quiz, they will be expected to take it on the day of their return.

10% - Homework Homework will be given daily. Homework will be graded on the basis of completion.

40% - Classwork

It is imperative that students engage in and complete all classwork. Classwork may be given in the form of independent or collaborative assignments, interactive notebook assignments, notebook checks, or any other type of assignment the teacher deems appropriate.

10% - Participation

Daily class participation and good citizenship is expected of every student. Students are expected to respectfully engage in class discussions and contribute to the learning community.

HOMework

All homework assignments are to be completed neatly and submitted on the due date. Homework is vital in reinforcing and extending students' learning of critical themes and concepts. If a student misses a homework assignment it must be turned in the next day. If a student misses more than one homework assignment, a home contact will be made.

ABSENCES AND MISSED WORK

It is the responsibility of the student to collect any work they have missed due to an absence. Missed work will be located in the folder marked for that weekday on the "Absent" board. Students should come to the teacher for clarification if necessary. Work that is due on the day of an absence should be handed in the day of the student's return to school.

Missed work due to an absence of 3 or more days must be handed in within one week of the student's return to school unless another arrangement is made with the teacher. Work missed due to absences of 1-2 days in length must be handed in within 2 days of the student's return to school.

LATE WORK

All assignments will be accepted up to one week after the due date. For each day an assignment is handed in late, ten percent will be deducted.
