- Doors will be open Tuesday, 3/31 from 8:30-2:30 for pick-up. It is critical that every student has their materials picked up.

- Phase II of Distance Learning will include an increase in live teaching lessons, and significantly more accountability for the upper grades. Attendance and assignments remain a high priority. Nursery - grade 4 classes have more flexibility to meet the needs of all essential employee parents still working.
