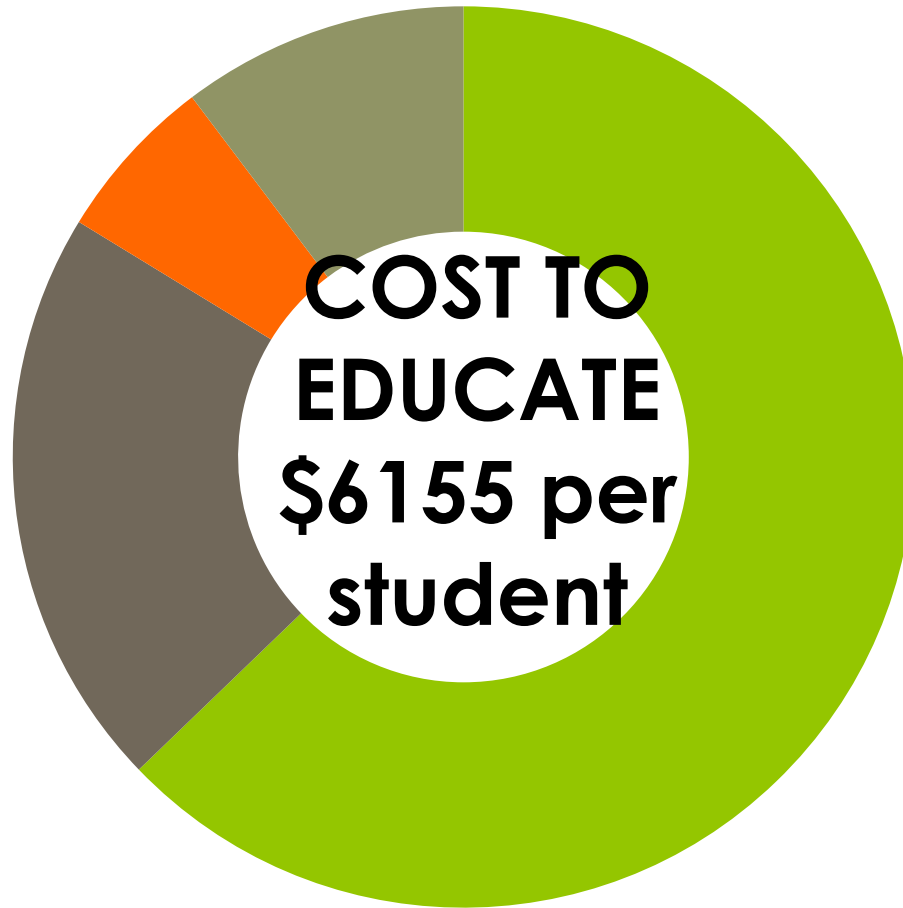

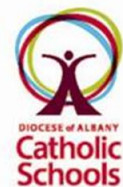

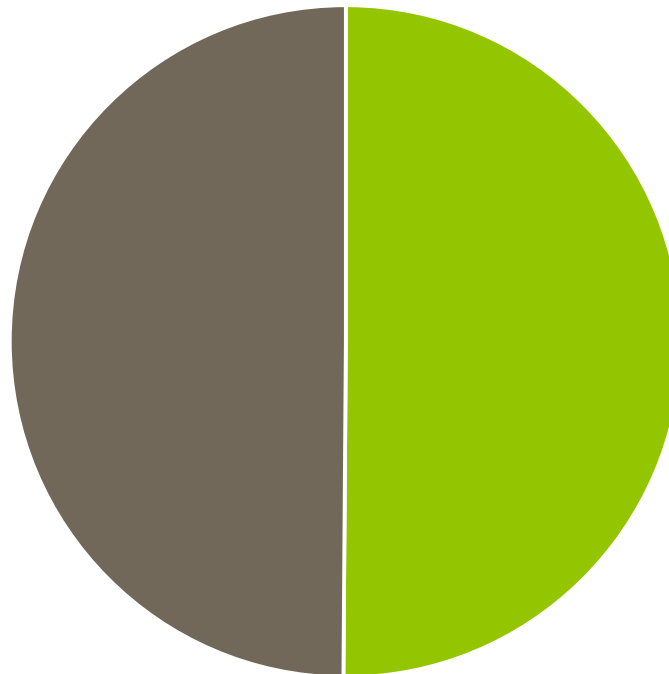

# School Uniforms

- Grades Nursery– Grade 8
  - Proper uniform expected by ALL grades
  - **Spirit shirts** are **NOT** gym shirts
  - Sneakers are not acceptable with dress uniforms\*
  - School shoes worn with dress uniform (Girls & Boys)
  - NO boots with uniform (snow and rain boots are to be changed OUTSIDE of the classrooms)
  - **NO hoodies** or street clothes with uniform
  - A Neck Tie is required with oxford shirt
  - Peter Pan blouse worn with Jumper (Nursery – Gr. 4 Girls)
  - Screen printed polo worn with Skirt (Gr.4 -8)
  - Land's End Skort w/ASCA polo styled shirt (Girls Nursery – Gr. 8)
  - Black socks for Boys
  - Maroon, white or gray socks/tights for Girls
  - **NO COLORED SOCKS WITH GYM UNIFORM**
- \* **PreK & Kindergarten students may wear black sneakers with dress uniform**

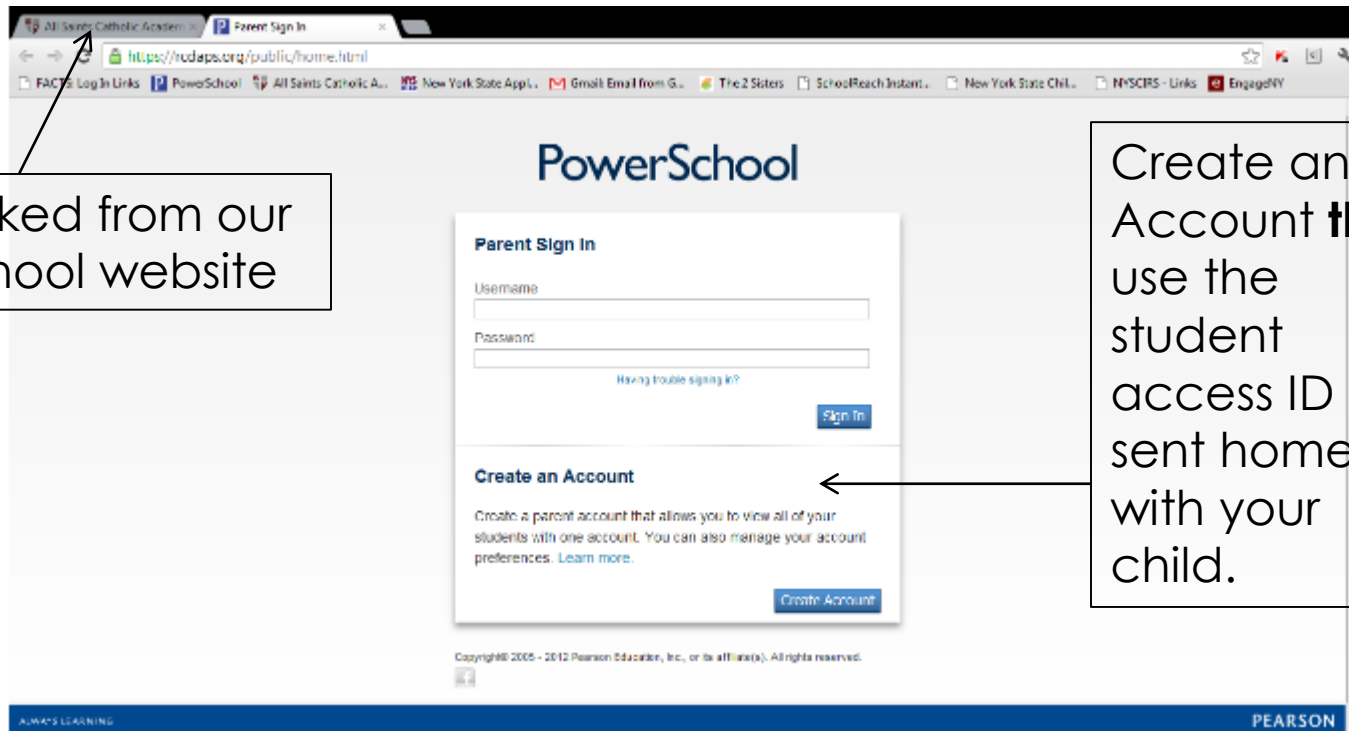


# NYS Next Generation Learning Standards & State Assessments
